## Homework

**Maths** A maths activity will be set once a week. Children are also expected to spend some time each day on TTRockstars to improve their Times Table recall.

**GAPS** A grammar and/or punctuation activity will be set once a week.

**Spellings** Each week we will focus on a specific spelling rule and children will be tested on words related to these rules at the end of the week. You may wish to visit these at home to complement the work we are doing in school. A copy of the weekly lists can be found on our Year 6 Google Classroom.

**Further Homework** If you would like further homework, I would recommend the Year 6 CGP revision books which will help greatly with your child's revision. We will send out a way to purchase these in the coming weeks.
