



**Bolshaw Primary School**  
**OUR UNIFORM/APPEARANCE RULES**



Bolshaw School gender-neutral uniform.

The rules below apply to all children whether they are male or female.

- Pinafores or skirts should be **NAVY BLUE**, and **NOT GREY** (No shorter than 5cm (2") above the knee)
- Cardigan must be navy with green stripe
- V neck jumper must be navy with green stripe
- Trousers should be **CHARCOAL GREY**
- Shirts should be **WHITE** (preferably short sleeved, especially in Key Stage 1) (no polo shirts)
- Ties should be worn with the wider end at the front and at least four stripes of the same colour visible below the knot
- Socks should be grey, black, navy blue or white
- Tights should be navy or black
- **NO** coloured or striped socks or tights
- Navy blue T-shirt for P.E. with or without the Bolshaw logo, plus navy blue shorts or cycling shorts
- Navy blue tracksuits may be worn in the winter (Hoody to be introduced October 22)
- All Year 1 to Year 6 children should have trainers for outdoor PE, not pumps. Reception children do not require either.
- Shoes should be black or navy, flat and sensible (Ballet style shoes without a strap are no longer acceptable for Health & Safety reasons)
- **NO** ankle or knee-high boots should be worn in school
- Sandals should be navy, black or white and the toes must be covered for Health & Safety reasons (No peep toes)
- Hairstyles should be sensible, if hair is shoulder length or longer it **MUST** be tied back for Health & Safety reasons
- **NO** gel should be worn in hair, **NO** coloured hair, **NO** Mohicans, **NO** shaved patterns
- Religious headscarves should be plain and navy blue
- Hair bobbles/ribbons/slides/headbands should be navy, green or black
- **NO** jewellery. Although we would prefer that children do not wear earrings to school, if they are worn it should be no more than one plain gold or silver stud per ear
- **NO** nail varnish or tattoos (including temporary)
- **NO** make-up or fake tan
- **SUMMER UNIFORM** can only be worn from after the Easter holiday until the end of September
- Summer dresses/playsuits can be blue or green, check or striped (No shorter than 5cm (2") above the knee)
- Shorts must be charcoal grey
- Sun hats must be worn for outdoor play/activities (Please ensure your child/children has/have one)
- Children should wear the correct items of clothing at all times.
